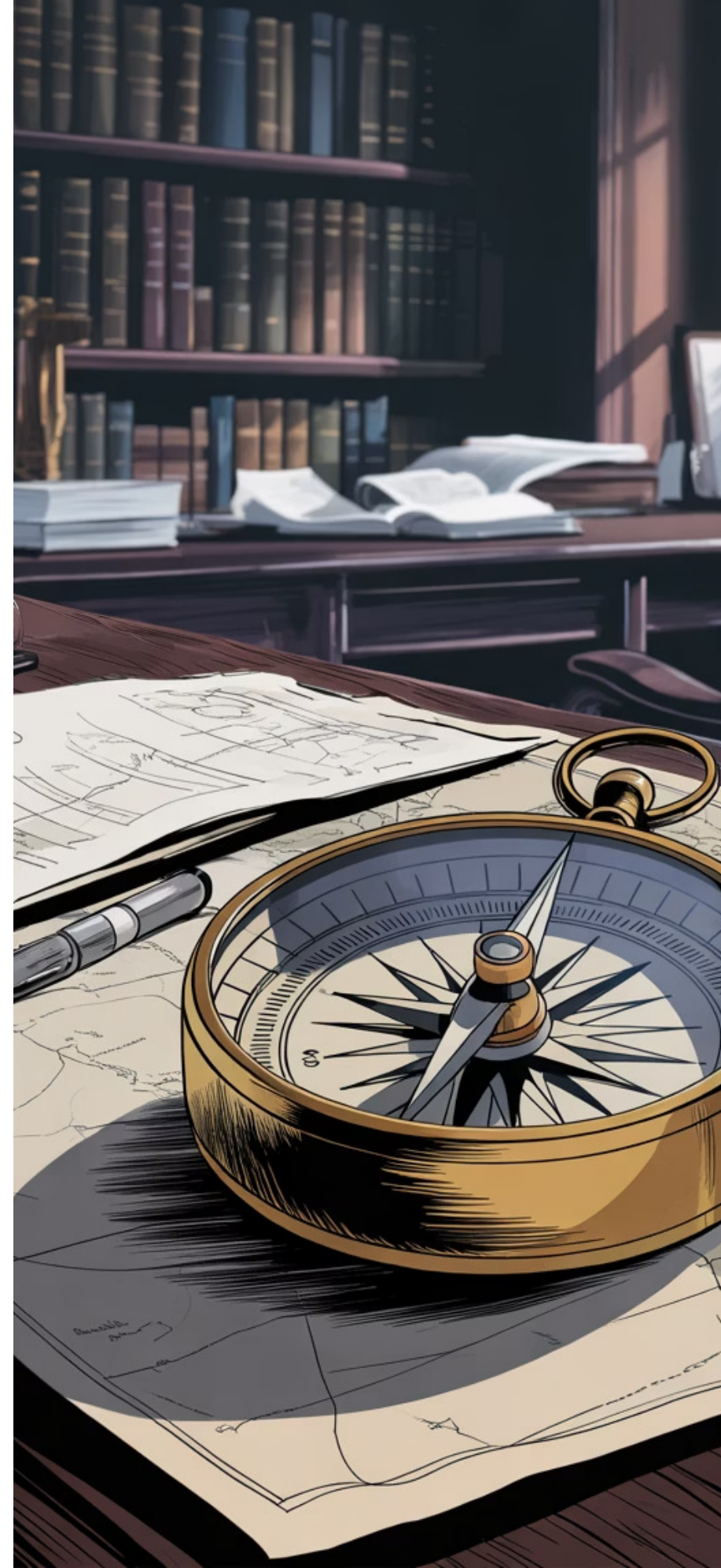

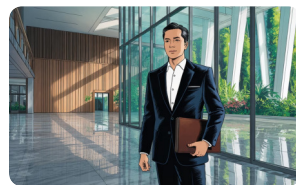
Day 1 & 2: Foundations

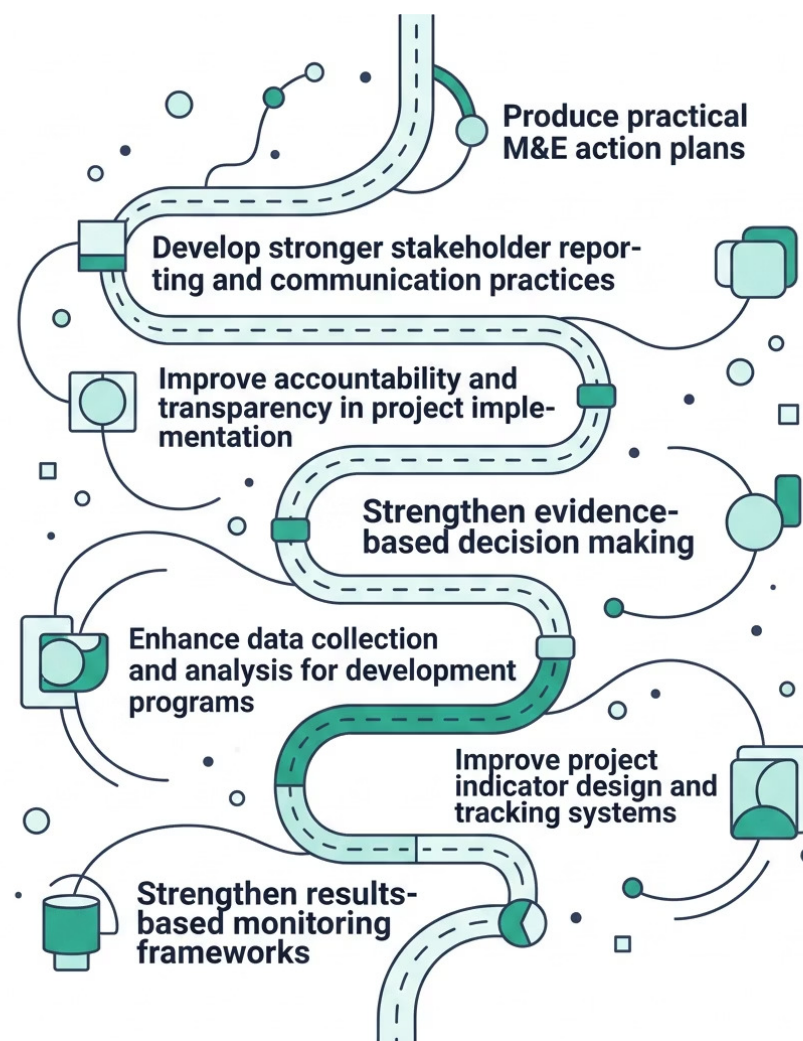
